Pastor Scott's Issue: Fiskehus

Everyone that enjoys keeping fish that have been caught needs a place to clean fish. We call it a fish house. Here is the fish house, a temporary structure, now located at the parsonage. It is constructed of mostly recycled materials (thanks to those who contributed) and at no cost to the church. The fish house provides shelter from the elements, especially the mosquitos. It provides a place for "tools of the trade" in addition to clean work surfaces and supplies such as water and cleaning aids.



This is now a daily reminder of the spiritual shelter we have in the Lord. The Biblical references to the Lord as our shelter are numerous but Psalm 91 seems most appropriate for the Fish House metaphor, "Those who go to God Most High for safety will be protected by the Almighty. I will say to the Lord, 'You are my place of safety and protection. You are my God and I trust you.'"

A shelter provides physical functions. The most obvious function is a place: a location to call home. Shelters provide physical protection from outside influences. A shelter provides resources such as place to rest, a place for fellowship and a place for worship. But shelters provide much more than physical blessings, shelters provide spiritual blessings. When we are sheltered we find a place where we can trust. We can trust in the Lord. When sheltered by God we find ourselves in the "shadow of His wings": comfort is found shelter. And there is healing in His wings: being sheltered provides respite for the weary and heavily burdened. And the spiritual blessings abound in being sheltered by God Most High: peace, patience, perseverance and hope to name a few.

In John's Gospel he recounts Jesus' appearing to the disciples after His resurrection. He didn't build a fish house but He built a breakfast fire upon which he baked some bread and cooked some fish for the disciples. He created a "shelter": a place filled with love, warmth and service. He created a space where the disciples would feel at home with their Lord and Savior.

May you find shelter in the Lord.
