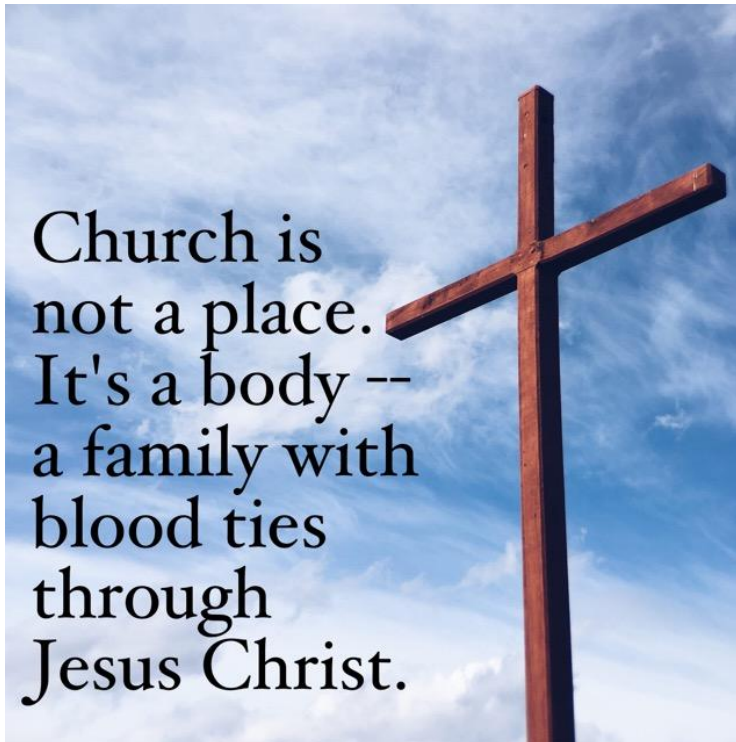

Dear Church



As I write this June letter, it feels like there is a growing sense around our church family of, “We are stepping into something new.” The snow is gone, the lakes are alive again, and all around us creation reminds us that life continues to move forward. That is true in nature, and it is also true in the Kingdom of God.

On Sundays, we continue our series called *EPIC*, inspired by the book by John Eldredge. We have been looking at the grand story of Scripture — creation, rebellion, rescue, restoration, and the coming Kingdom of God. The Bible is not a collection of disconnected stories or moral lessons. It is one unfolding story of a God who has not abandoned His world and who continues to draw humanity back into His life and love.

Sometimes it is easy to look at the world around us and feel discouraged or uncertain. Yet the gospel reminds us that we are living inside a much bigger story than the headlines of the moment.

As Scripture says: *“He has made everything beautiful in its time.” — Ecclesiastes 3:11*

And again: *“Behold, I am making all things new.” — Revelation 21:5*

June also marks a special milestone for our church family. Our new Gathering Place is nearing completion, and on the last Sunday of June we plan to celebrate our very first outdoor worship service together at the pavilion. What began as an old building with uncertainty surrounding its future is becoming a place of gathering, prayer, fellowship, meals, teaching, and community life.

In many ways, that building has become a picture of the gospel itself. God delights in restoring what people overlook. He brings life where others see only limitations. He renews what seems worn down. And He invites ordinary people into His unfolding story.

As we enter this summer season together, my encouragement is simple: do not lose sight of the larger story God is telling. Your life is not random. Your prayers matter. Your faithfulness matters. Small acts of love, worship, generosity, and obedience are all part of the Kingdom quietly growing among us.

We are not simply attending church services. We are participating in the great EPIC of God.

ROOTED CAMPAIGN: ANNEX RENOVATION UPDATE

We are 13 months into the Annex renovation project. Overall progress is really happening fast now. It is very exciting.

Inside the plaster is done, and painting is happening. Electrical outlets and switches going in. The siding is going up, and pavilion south wall is being finished.

In June we will be getting things completed in various areas. Getting ready for the **1st OUTDOOR SERVICE**. Complete the siding. Finish the pavilion. Finish electrical. Energize the building. Install HVAC. Attic insulation. New sidewalks.

Work will continue into July, with our goal of a Grand opening at the end of July in conjunction with our outdoor service and church picnic.
